



Partnering with the School to Address Bullying Concerns

Set Up a Plan

- Meet with school administrators
- Take a trusted friend with you
- Ask the school to designate a safe point person for your child
- Remind administrators that you do not wish for your child to be viewed as a snitch or tattle-tale
- Agree on how you and the school will monitor progress
- Follow-up with an email summarizing next steps

Support Your Child

Here are some questions to ask when meeting with the school:

- Who will conduct the investigation?
- Will there be a joint meeting with the other child's parents?
- How long will the investigation take?
- What is the best way to follow-up?
- What should I tell my child?
- What will be done to ensure that the other child acts differently toward my child?
- How will my child and I know this has been addressed?
